

Project Development Internship Opportunity

The Cognitive Engineering Research Institute is offering a Project Development Internship opportunity for graduate or Ph.D. students for the Fall 2007/Spring 2008 year.

This internship will allow the student to be involved with the development of Women in Science, a program aimed at outreach, advocacy, and training for women. Although this internship focuses on women in science, it is available to both men and women. The internship duties will include: identification of potential grant sponsors, familiarization of grant submission requirements, design of internal infrastructure of non-profit organizations, development of multimedia materials, and proposal writing. This internship will last approximately nine months and will require 10 to 20 hours per week of work.

Preferred qualifications include:

- Currently pursuing a MBA, M.S., or Ph.D. in Business Administration, Public Programs Administration, Community Resources and Development, Non-Profit Studies, or a related discipline
- Completed first-year of graduate-level coursework
- B.A. or B.S. in a related field
- Experience with a not-for-profit institute
- Good communication skills
- Ability to work effectively with others
